

The Round House



The Round House is a prestigious accommodation attracting the coveted Visit England Gold Award every year since it opened. A generously spacious (700 SqFt, 65 SqM) and warm home with abundant light and open to the rafters. Stone flagged (save in the carpeted bedroom) with underfloor heating. The marble-topped kitchen is fully equipped to a high standard. The lounge benefits from high quality upholstery and a suitably large television. The bathroom offers a choice between walk-in shower and cast roll-top bath. The main bedroom is equipped with solid oak furniture and can be provided as a twin or super-king double. A small staircase inside the bedroom takes you up into the rafters where you'll find a delightful crow's nest equipped as a single bedroom.





The Round House at Boningale Manor was built in the late 1600's as a Horse Engine Shed and served as the mill for the farm & valley. The original structure was simply a circular roof supported by 5 pillars, keyed into the granary by a gable. You can still see the stone slot worn by being slapped by the leather drive bands. The Round House later served as stabling and features in the bedroom area echo those times.
